Credit Union Shared Branching

With shared branching, credit union members can have the convenience and security of conducting teller transactions as if it were their own local credit union office, no matter where they travel nationwide.

When you're on the road, you can walk into any shared branch and conduct business; you can:

Find a credit union or ATM

- Deposit, withdraw, or transfer funds
- Cash a check
- Make loan payments
- Make a balance inquiry
- Get money orders or travelers checks*

Each shared branch has automatic access to your regular account and works just like your regular Credit Union branches. Now you can conduct business all over town, all over the state, and all over the country at any CU Service Center.*

** Some fees may be associated with either shared branching or certain transactions. Check with your home credit union for more details.*
